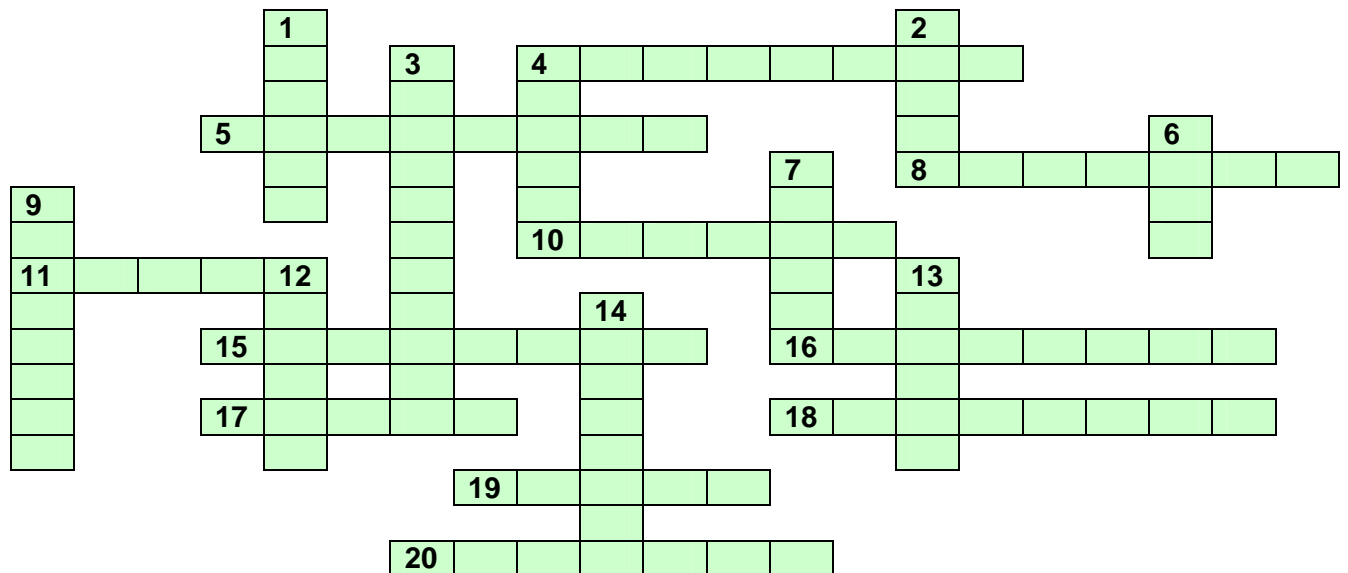

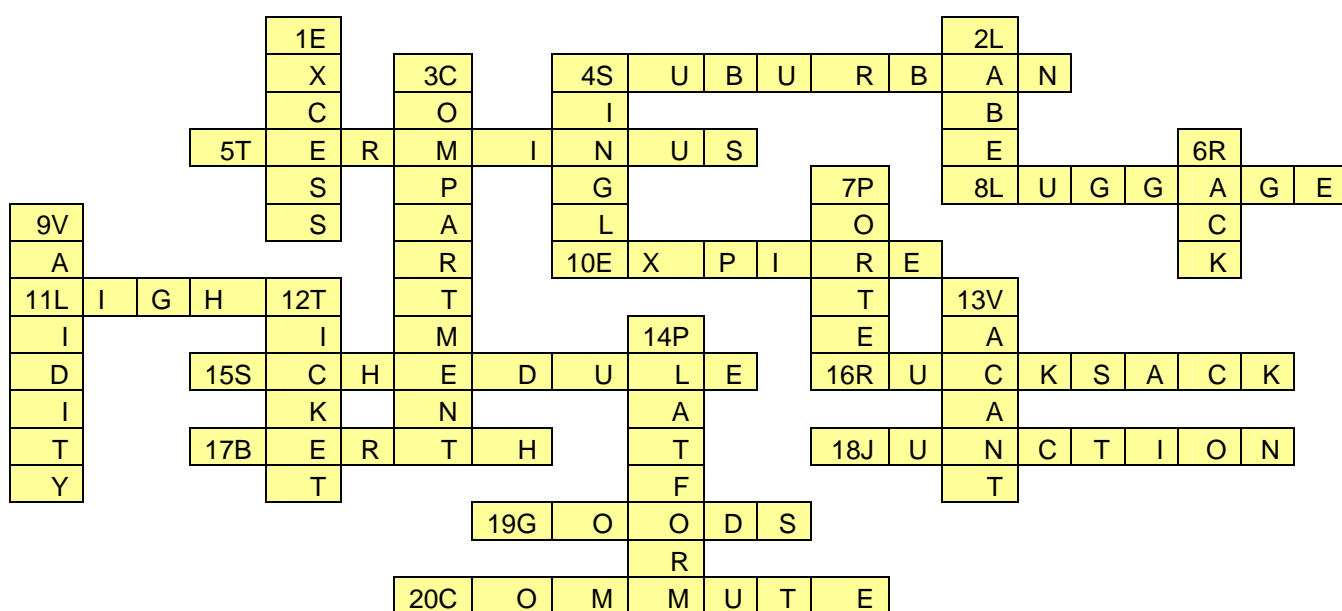
## *Across:*
