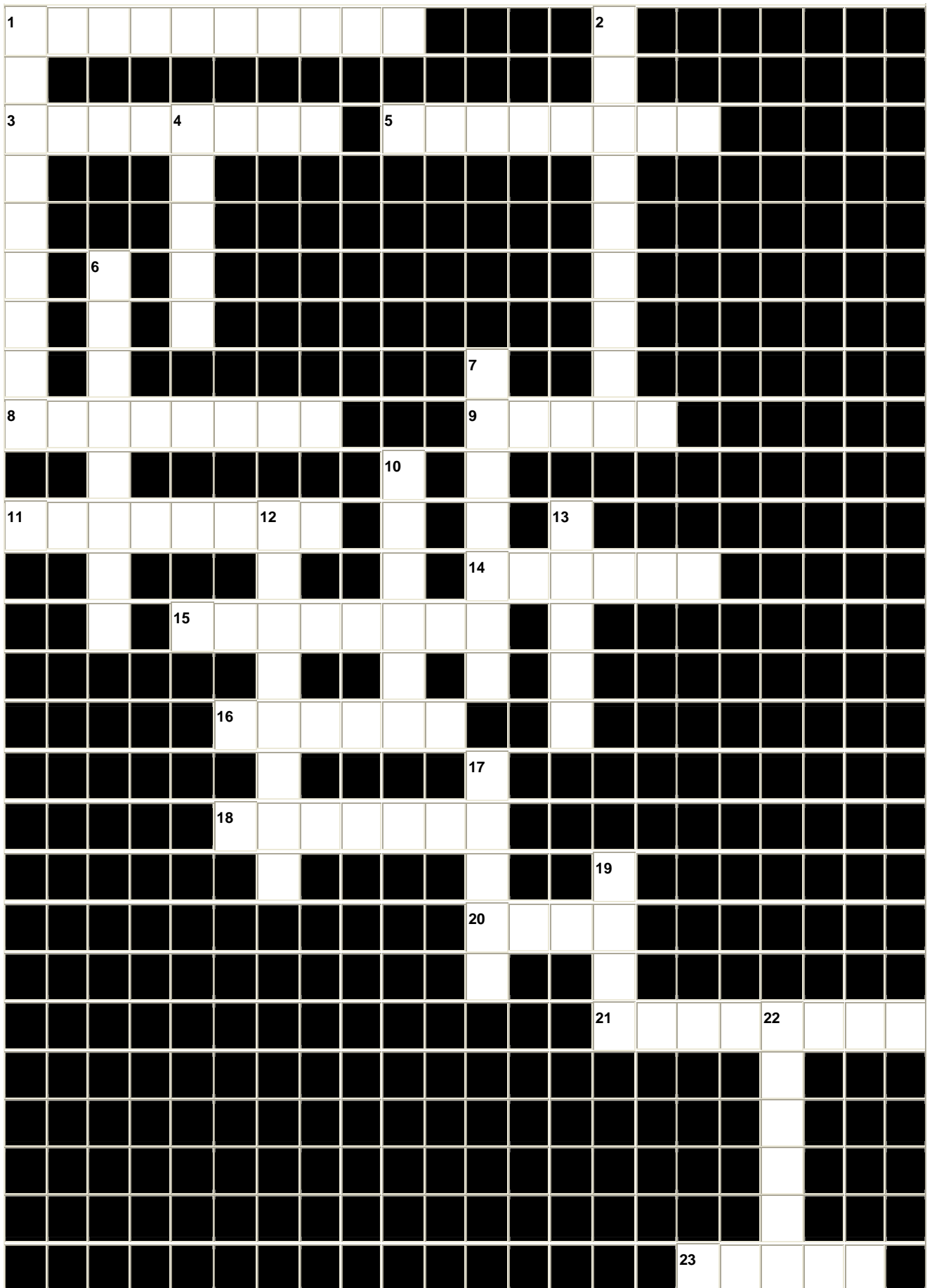

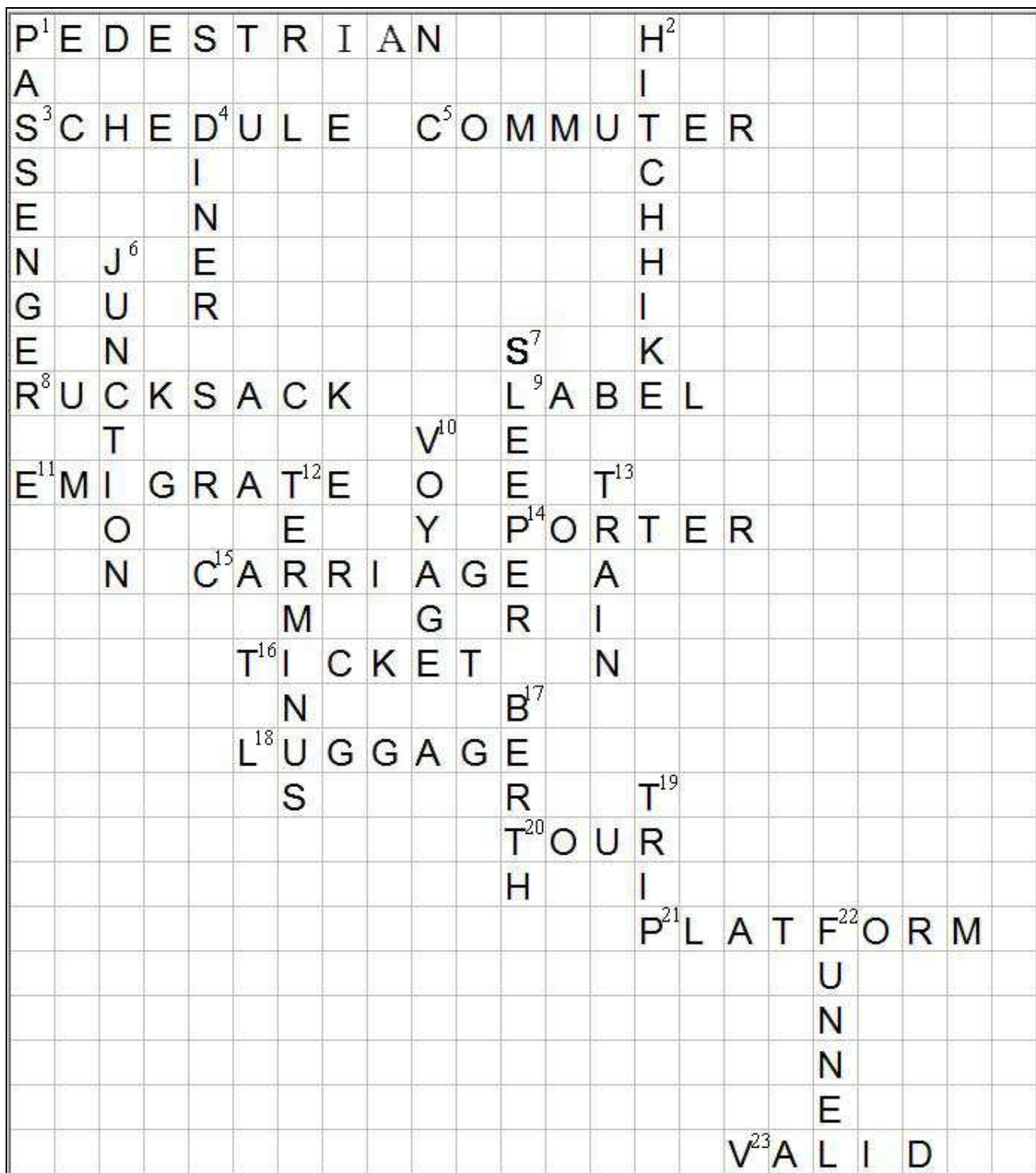
Across:

- 1** a person walking in the street
- 3** a list of times of arrivals and departures of trains
- 5** a person who travels regularly (e.g. to work) usually from the suburbs to the centre of a city
- 8** a large bag carried on the back and often used by climbers, campers, etc.
- 9** a piece of paper, card, or other material attached to luggage to identify it or give instructions or details concerning its ownership, use, nature, destination, etc.
- 11** to leave one place or country, esp. one's native country, in order to settle in another
- 14** a person employed to carry passengers' luggage at a railway station
- 15** a railway coach for passengers
- 16** a piece of paper or cardboard giving the holder the right to travel on a train, bus, etc.
- 18** suitcases, trunks, etc. containing personal belongings for a journey
- 20** an extended journey, usually taken for pleasure, visiting places of interest along the route
- 21** a raised area at a railway station from which passengers have access to the trains
- 23** having legal force

Down:

- 1** a person travelling in a car, train, boat, etc., not driven by him
- 2** to travel by obtaining free lifts in motor vehicles
- 4** a railway coach in which meals are served at tables
- 6** a place where several routes, lines, or roads meet, link, or cross each other
- 7** a carriage in a train with beds
- 10** a journey by sea
- 12** an end of a railway, bus route, etc.
- 13** a line of coaches or wagons joined together and drawn by a railway locomotive
- 17** a bed in a train, usually narrow and fixed to a wall
- 19** an outward and return journey, often for a specific purpose
- 22** a vertical metal pipe on the top of a ship or steam train through which smoke comes out
