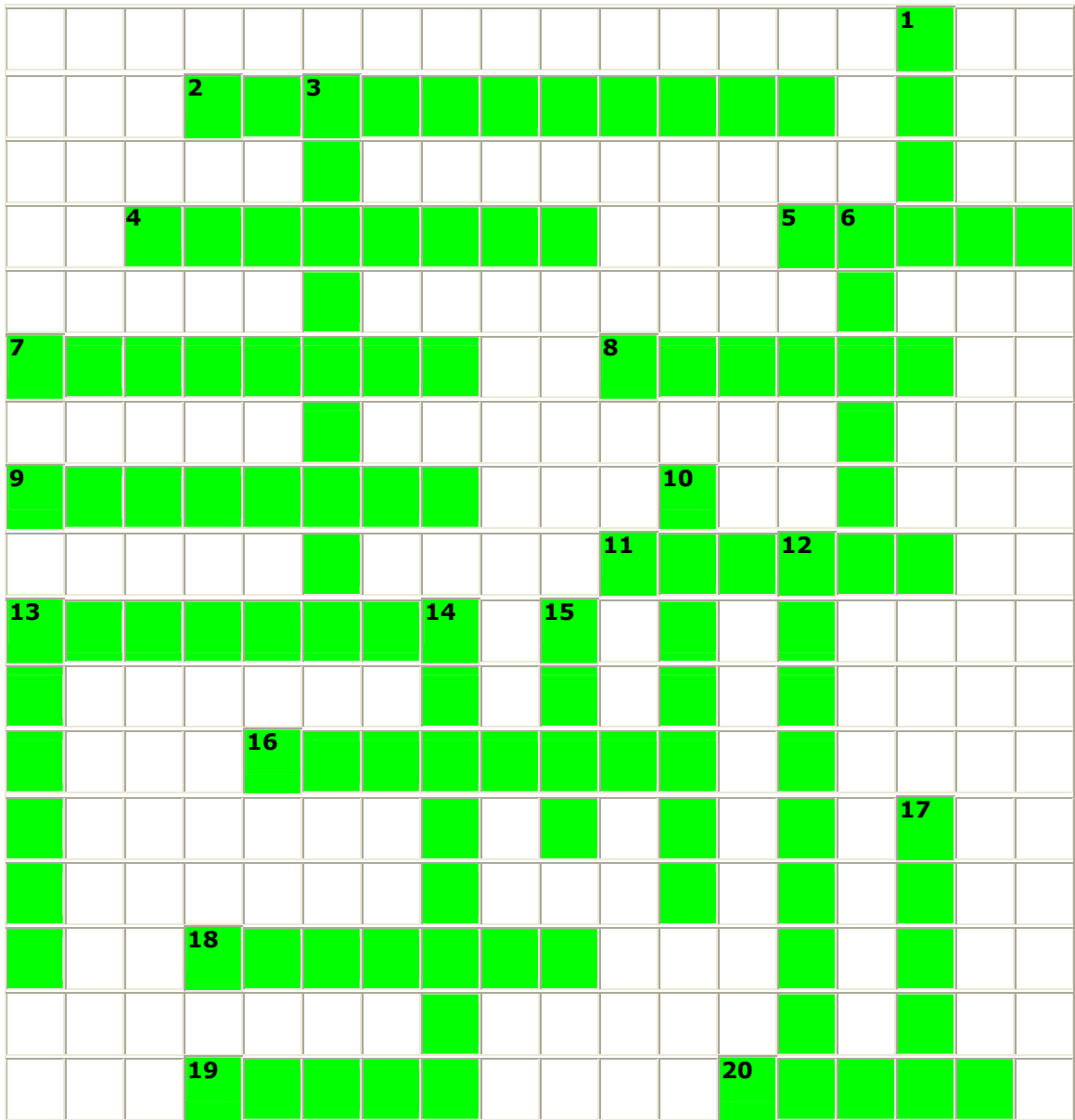


# Travelling



## Across:

- 2** An unpleasant feeling caused by the motion of a ship.
- 4** A case with flat sides and a handle, used for carrying clothes, etc. when travelling.
- 5** A boat, that carries people and goods across a river, canal, lake, etc.
- 7** The end of a railway or tram line or of a bus or air route, also the station or town at that place.
- 8** A rather long journey, especially by water or air.
- 9** A separate section of a train for carrying passengers.
- 11** A person whose job is carrying people's luggage and other loads.
- 13** A person who has a commutation ticket and travels to and from regularly (e.g. from a suburb to the city).
- 16** A place where two or more roads or railway lines meet.
- 18** The boxes, bags, suitcases, trunks, etc. taken on a journey.
- 19** A person who works at a booking-office.
- 20** A big box with a hinged lid used to hold the belongings of one who is travelling.

## Down:

- 1** A journey in which a short stay is made at a number of places, the traveller finally returning to the place from which he started.
- 3** A person who takes care of the passengers in a train.
- 6** A machine that pulls a railway train.
- 10** The act of going from one place to another, usually taking a rather long time.
- 12** A person who goes from place to place in search of pleasure, adventure, etc.
- 13** A sea-voyage from port to port, especially a pleasure trip.
- 14** A canvas bag used by walkers and climbers for holding clothes, food, etc., and carried on the back.
- 15** A journey, an excursion, frequently a brief one, made by land or water.
- 17** A small room (especially for sleeping in) in a ship or aeroplane.
